

# TEMPLETON - ESTERO BAY - SOUTH BAY -CAMBRIA Youth Soccer - End of Season Tournament Rules 2019 – 10U Division

## Tournament:

All games except the Championship game will consist of two 20-minute halves

There will be a 5-minute break at half time

Format will be a single elimination gameplay

This is a recreational youth soccer tournament and all players will play at least half the game unless injured or player is refusing to play

## Rulings:

Tie breakers will go directly to a best of 5 player shoot out (Penalty Kicks) to determine the winner

The clock will not stop for injuries or any other reason

## Substitutions:

Are allowed on your possession of a throw in.

- Prior to a goal kick by either team
- After a goal is score by either team
- In replacing an injured player
- If the opposing team decides to substitute you may piggy back and substitute as well.

Build out line will still be in effect

- All opposing players must remain behind the line during all goal kicks and not subject to cross until the ball has touched a team player or has gone outside the penalty box
- If players are seen crossing the line before any of this has happened a re-kick will be established and next one will result in a free kick outside the penalty box
- Once the goalie has caught or received the ball with their hands all opposing players must head to the build out line. If the goalie decides to put the ball into play before the players have made it past the line, then the ball is live, and the goalie cannot pick it up with their hands it must be kicked.

## Championship game:

Will consist of two 25-minute halves

There will be a 5-minute break at half time

Tie breakers will go directly to a best of 5 player shoot out (Penalty Kicks) to determine the winner

***Except as set forth above, all regular season rules as established by the host association will apply during the tournament.***
